With AKT, MSP's Subscribe to Open program now consists of six journals:

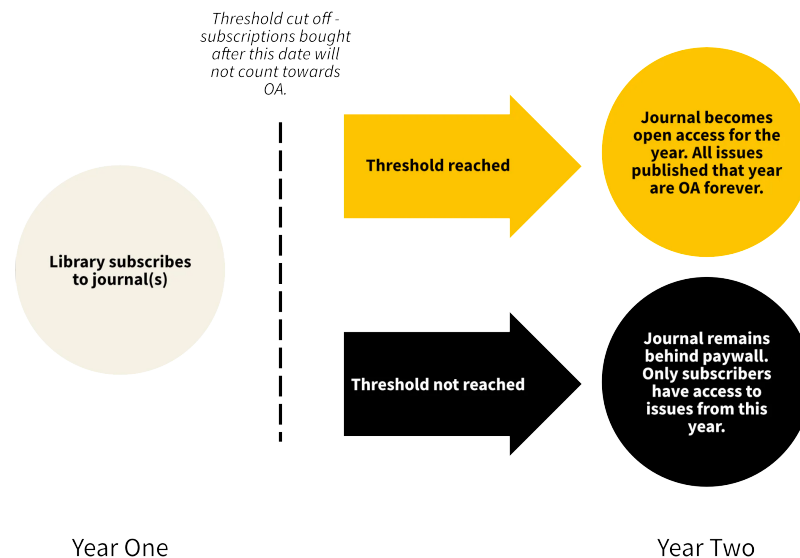
- *Algebra & Number Theory*,

If a journal in the S2O program does not receive enough commitments to subscribe before February 15, then only paid subscribers will have access to 2027 content.

Additionally, if the year remains locked, then a higher price is charged for orders received after the deadline.

Whether or not the participation threshold is met, **all paying subscribers will receive all the usual benefits of a traditional subscription.**



The continued success of our Subscribe to Open program, and the journals in it, depends heavily on the participation of our library subscribers. Only consistent and early subscription confirmations can ensure the long-term sustainability of our open-access content.
