Professor James Burnham has pointed out to me that Proposition 3.3 is incorrect. In fact a crucial hypothesis has been omitted. The following hypothesis should be added to the statements of Proposition 3.3, Theorem 3.4, and Theorem 4.2:

$B \cdot [A \cdot B]$ is dense in A in the A -norm .

Here $B \cdot A$ is the ideal generated by elements of the form ba where $b \in B, a \in A$.
